4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions of law do not apply to procurement by
5 the Department of General Services for the renovation of a structure ~~built during~~
6 ~~certain centuries or~~ listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic
7 Places, to the extent necessary to preserve the historic fabric of the structure, as
8 determined by the Department in consultation with the Maryland ~~Historic~~ Historical

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Finance and Procurement

11–203.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does not
apply to:

(1) procurement by:

(xvii) the Department of General Services for the ~~renovation~~
REHABILITATION of a structure that:

~~1. was built during the 18th or 19th century; [and] OR~~

~~2.~~ is listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of
Historic Places, **TO THE EXTENT THE PROCUREMENT IS NECESSARY TO PRESERVE**
THE HISTORIC FABRIC OF THE STRUCTURE IMPACTED BY THE REHABILITATION, AS
DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IN CONSULTATION
WITH THE MARYLAND ~~HISTORIC~~ HISTORICAL TRUST; and

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
1, 2017.
