2 **St. Mary's County – Leonardtown – Disposition of Alcoholic Beverages Licenses**
3 **Fees**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain requirement relating to the fees received for alcoholic
5 beverages licenses in St. Mary's County to require the County Treasurer to pay over
6 fees received for licenses issued for premises within the limits of the incorporated
7 Town of Leonardtown instead of premises in Leonardtown; and generally relating to
8 alcoholic beverages licenses fees in St. Mary's County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 The County Treasurer shall:

5 (1) collect the license fees; and

6 (2) pay over to the Commissioners of Leonardtown the fees received for
7 licenses issued for premises [in] **WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF**
8 Leonardtown.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2018.
