(II) The Board consists of the Secretaries of Natural Resources, Agriculture, and the Environment and the Director of Planning and a member of the Garrett County Commissioners, who shall be a voting member of the Board only on matters

The Scenic and Wild Rivers Review Board shall select the members of 20(3)21each local advisory board as follows: 22(i) At least [2] TWO members shall own land contiguous to the 23scenic or wild river, except for the Youghiogheny River where at least [3] THREE members 24shall own land contiguous to that portion of the river designated by § 8-408(a) of this 25subtitle as a wild river; 26At least [2] TWO members who own land that is not contiguous (ii) to the scenic or wild river; 27[1] **ONE** member shall represent the local governing body; and 28(iii) 29[2] **TWO** members from the county soil conservation district. 18	(f) (1) Each member of a local advisory board may not:

$25 \\ 26 \\ 27$	(g) (1) [Upon] ON completion of an approved management plan, the local governing body may establish a scenic river advisory board for each designated scenic or wild river within its jurisdiction.
$28 \\ 29$	(2) Each board, as constituted by the local authority, may recommend policies, laws, and regulations in furtherance of the aims of this subtitle to the appropriate
