## Health Care Facilities – Change in Bed Capacity – Certificate of Need Exemption

- 4 FOR the purpose of exempting an increase or decrease in bed capacity from the certificate 5 of need requirement if the increase or decrease will occur in a certain intermediate 6 care facility, or a certain general hospice program, or a certain hospital with acute 7 psychiatric beds under certain circumstances and certain written notice is filed with 8 the Maryland Health Care Commission at least a certain number of days before 9 increasing or decreasing bed capacity; requiring the Commission to review a certain chapter of the State Health Plan and, under certain circumstances, report to certain 10 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; making a technical 11 change; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to 12 13 certificates of need for a change in bed capacity.
