28. Comments

Located in Bethesda, Maryland, Little Falls Stream Valley Park offers both recreational and conservation-based resources. Associated with the Capital Crescent Trail, it is one of the most popular parks in Montgomery County, providing an important outdoor amenity to the densely populated and diverse community residing in District 19.

Little Falls Trail has been an important asset to the adjacent neighborhood and larger community to provide outdoor recreation and access to the Stream Valley Park. It also serves as a connection to the Bethesda Pool and Little Falls Parkway. In recent years the trail has complemented Montgomery Parks Open Parkway Program and provided safety outdoors activities. Trail usage has increased throughout Montgomery Parks as a result of the pandemic, which has highlighted the need to renovate older amenities like the Little Falls Trail. Also, this area was developed prior to the advent of stormwater management practices and unfortunately contributes to the poor ecological condition of the Willett Branch. Funding for this project will allow Parks to retrofit stormwater management techniques and environmental enhancements into the stream valley buffer. The asphalt which constitutes the hard surface trails must be replaced once it begins to deteriorate to maintain a safe and pleasant experience for Park users. Little Falls Stream Valley Park features miles of hard surface trail which are maintained by Montgomery Parks, however, there is not enough funding in the budget to allow us to make comprehensive renovations to all trail systems as quickly as they are needed.

With the funding from the State, Montgomery Parks will be able to move the timing of the trail renovation up considerably, delivering a renovated trail to the community more quickly than the normal asset replacement schedule allows. The existing asphalt on this trail, which is in poor condition, will be replaced and upgraded to meet the current ADA accessibility requirements for outdoor trails. This upgrade will allow broader access on the trail to amenities throughout the park for users with varying physical abilities. While work crews are making these vital upgrades, associated drainage improvements and shoulder stabilization will also improve the overall quality of the trail.
