AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1, AS AMENDED
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Judiciary Committee Amendments (SB0001/833728/1), in line 5 of Amendment No. 1, after “locations,” insert “requiring the Department of State Police to conduct a study of the commission of gun-related criminal offenses by individuals issued a permit to wear, carry, or transport a firearm;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 20 of the bill, after line 18, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) The Department of State Police shall conduct a study of the commission of gun-related criminal offenses by individuals issued a permit to wear, carry, or transport a firearm.

(b) The study shall include:

(1) data on the number of gun-related criminal offenses committed by individuals issued a permit to wear, carry, or transport a firearm; and

(2) an analysis comparing the number of gun-related criminal offenses committed by permit holders and individuals who do not have a permit.

(c) The Department of State Police may consult trade groups or organizations and academic institutions to conduct the study.

(d) On or before October 1, 2024, the Department of State Police shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.”.

On page 9 of the Judiciary Committee Amendments, in the first line from the bottom of Amendment No. 6, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.
