12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Safety**

15 **12-817.**

16 **NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A LANDLORD OR**
17 **LANDLORD'S AGENT OR PROPERTY OWNER OR PROPERTY OWNER'S AGENT MAY**
18 **ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AN ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR LICENSED UNDER THIS**

SUBTITLE OTHER THAN THE ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR WITH WHOM THE LANDLORD
OR PROPERTY OWNER HAS A CONTRACT WITHOUT PENALTY IF:

(1) THE ELEVATOR IS:

(I) LOCATED IN A ~~MULTIFAMILY DWELLING UNIT~~ RESIDENTIAL
OCCUPANCY IN WHICH A DISABLED ~~TENANT~~ OCCUPANT OR A ~~TENANT~~ OCCUPANT
WHO IS AT LEAST 60 YEARS OLD RESIDES; AND

(II) OUT OF SERVICE; AND

(2) THE ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR WITH WHOM THE LANDLORD OR
LANDLORD'S AGENT OR PROPERTY OWNER OR PROPERTY OWNER'S AGENT INTENDS
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IS ABLE TO REPAIR THE ELEVATOR BEFORE THE
ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR WITH WHOM THE LANDLORD OR PROPERTY OWNER HAS A
CONTRACT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2023.
