A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Recreational Crabbing License – Exemption**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting persons under a certain age from the requirement to obtain
4 a recreational crabbing license to catch or attempt to catch crabs for recreational
5 purposes in the waters of the Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries; and generally
6 relating to exemptions from the requirement to obtain a recreational crabbing
7 license.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Natural Resources**

16 **4–805.**

17 **A PERSON MAY CATCH OR ATTEMPT TO CATCH CRABS FOR RECREATIONAL**
18 **PURPOSES IN THE WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES**
19 **WITHOUT A RECREATIONAL CRABBING LICENSE IF THE PERSON IS UNDER THE AGE**
20 **OF 16 YEARS.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
22 1, 2023.
